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How to Graffiti a Text

Here are some ideas for what you can do when examining a line from a new text:

- Write what you think the text might mean and why you think so.
- Draw a representation of what you think the line might be talking about.
- Explain what the line makes you wonder about the story.

- Tell what plot information the line is giving.
- Write what the line tells you about the characters.
- Explain what might happen in a setting like this.
- Write about the kind of conflict the line is describing.
- Tell how this line reminds you of something in your own life or in the world. What? How?
- Tell how this line reminds you of something else you have read. What? How?
- Write a response to someone else's graffiti thoughts.

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
